1. 2019 National Cattle Congress Fair Queen/Princess will be present all 4 days of the 2019 National Cattle Congress Fair, September 12-15 2019. During the 4 days of Fair, the queen will be required to be at Dairy Show for awards and pictures, walk the grounds and meet with the crowd, welcome fairgoers at the gates, attend the Rodeo on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights, crown the new Little Miss & Mister Cattle Congress and several other fun activities during fair.
2. Queen will appear as the 2019 National Cattle Congress Queen in the majority of the counties parades during the 2019 & 2020 years. This includes but is not exclusive to My Waterloo Days, Hudson Days and Sturgis Falls. The Princess may also be asked to represent if there is a legitimate conflict.
3. Queen will be available and will participate in the 2019 Iowa State Fair Queen Competition held in Des Moines, August 6th – 10th. Queen will be available for the entire duration of the State Fair and will commit to these dates with no reservation. Other participation at the Iowa State Fair during these times is not possible. Transportation to and from the State Fair and spending money is the Queen's responsibility. Most meals and accommodations for the Iowa State Fair Queen Contest are included with the crown. If the 2019 National Cattle Congress Queen cannot not fully commit to these dates, the 1st runner up/Princess will be crowned Queen and go on her behalf to the State Fair Queen Contest.
4. If crowned the 2019 Iowa State Fair Queen, you agree to help to mentor future Queen Candidates when possible.
5. Queen agrees to be at the 2020 National Cattle Congress Queen Contest to crown the next Queen and Princess's (dates TBA). Upon completion of all Queen/Princess duties, the Queen will receive a \$100.00 from the National Cattle Congress at the 2020 NCC Fair Queen Competition.
