The National Cattle Congress is proud to continue this annual event for the youth involved with dairy projects through 4-H and FFA. National Cattle Congress Fair will once again crown a Supreme Junior Champion Dairy Heifer, as well as a Reserve and Honorable Mention. The winners will receive scholarships for college. Eligible participants for this particular event must be a member of a 4-H Club or FFA Chapter and must have won their county Supreme Junior Champion or Reserve Supreme Junior Champion of all the exhibiting dairy breeds. (Each County must crown an Overall Champion of the breeds to qualify.)

County Fairs

Each county fair is asked to crown a Supreme and Reserve Junior Champion Dairy Heifer* or Overall Champion Heifer of all dairy breeds exhibited.

As a champion or reserve champion you are being given a certificate and asked to fill out the form with your information. Please bring this completed form with you to the show and turn in to the Superintendent at check-in. There will be no entry fees for this particular event, but participants would be encouraged to enter in the National Cattle Congress Youth Dairy Show.

**Note: A Heifer is defined as a female cow that has not had a calf.*

A Substitute Showman will be allowed with prior approval.
