Each county fair is asked to crown a Supreme and Reserve Junior Champion Dairy <u>Heifer</u>\* (Overall Champion <u>Heifer</u> of all dairy breeds exhibited) As a champion or reserve champion you are being given a certificate and asked to fill out the form with your information. There will be no entry fees for this particular event, but participants would be encouraged to enter the National Cattle Congress Youth Dairy Show. A Substitute Showman will be allowed with prior approval.

\*Note: A <u>Heifer</u> is defined as a female cow that has not had a calf.
