The National Cattle Congress is proud to continue this annual event for the youth involved with dairy projects through 4-H and FFA. The National Cattle Congress Fair will once again crown a Supreme Junior Champion Dairy Heifer, as well as a Reserve, and Honorable Mention. The winners will receive scholarships for college. Eligible participants for this event must be a member of a 4-H Club or FFA Chapter and must have won their county Supreme Junior Champion or Reserve Supreme Junior Champion of all the exhibiting dairy breeds. (Each County must crown an Overall Champion of the breeds to qualify.)

County Fairs

Each county fair is asked to crown a Supreme and Reserve Junior Champion Dairy Heifer* (Overall Champion Heifer of all dairy breeds exhibited). As a champion or reserve champion, you will be given a certificate and asked to fill out the form with your information. There will be no entry fees for this particular event, however participants are encouraged to enter the National Cattle Congress Youth Dairy Show. A Substitute Showman will be allowed with prior approval.

**Note: A Heifer is defined as a female cow that has not had a calf.*

Supreme Champion Exhibits must be entered in the NCC Youth Show to compete in the Scholarship Show. Once entries are received (***deadline September 4, 2026***), NCC will mail out exhibitor information for completion.
